Monthly Recipe

Sweet BBQ Chicken Kabobs

Here's a heart-healthy, easy & Tasty dish - Enjoy!

- 1 - lb. boneless, skinless, Chicken breast, cut into 1" pieces.
 - 2 - cups pineapple chunks (fresh is best)
 - 1 - ea. Red/green pepper, seeded, cut into chunks
 - ½ - cup of BBQ sauce (whatever your choice)
 - 3 - tbsps frozen O.J. concentrate, thawed
- Pre-heat grill to med-high heat. Using 8 long skewers, thread chicken alternating with peppers & pineapple onto skewers. Mix O.J. and BBQ sauce, brush on Kabobs. Grill 8-10^{mins} until chicken is thoroughly cooked. Turn, brush occasionally with remaining sauce. Recipe may be doubled.
