ARCHITECTURAL & SITE IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE

If you get a White County Building Permit for any project that you are doing on your lot, it must be displayed outside where it can be viewed easily by the Building Inspector. Also, any permit issued by the Paradise Valley Architectural Committee should be placed in a zip lock bag and placed outside where it can be viewed as well.

If you plan on painting or staining your cabin or deck you do not need a park permit if you are using the same color. If you plan on changing colors, a park permit will be required.

If you have any question on what may

require a permit, feel free to ask any Architectural Committee member.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Sausage & Cheese Muffins

- 12 oz box bisquick mix
- Cups shredded sharp cheese
- 1 lb sausage
- Cups buttermilk

Brown, drain and cool sausage. Mix cheese into bisquick. Mix cooled sausage into mixture. Add buttermilk until very soft dough forms. Spray muffin pan with vegetable spray. Fill muffin pan with mixture, using ice cream scoop. Bake at 375° until golden brown. Makes approximately 20 muffins.
