USE OF PAVILION -

The pavilion may be used for private functions by campground members.



Private functions will not be permitted if the date conflicts with a regularly scheduled activity of the campground. Arrangements must be made through the Board of Directors and a fifty-dollar (\$50.00) deposit is required.



PARKING - No vehicle shall be parked on or along any street or service driveway or common property,

except as such area may be from time to time so designated for parking while work is being done in the park.

GUEST/RENTERS - Lot owners are responsible to ensure their guests/renters abide by all campground rules



and regulations and must provide a copy of the rules to anyone using or renting their lot. Please see the **Renters Protocols document on** paradisevalleycamp.com.

Help keep the bears at bay!



Please be aware of the possibility of bear(s) in the park, this usually happens in the spring! NO NEED TO PANIC! Be sure to take in your bird feeders at night and ensure all food is picked up and inside. Black bears are very opportunistic eaters, mostly eating grasses, roots, berries, fish, and insects (and
