## Recipes:

### B'fast Casserole -

- 1 - 9" unbaked frozen pie crust
- 1 tbs. butter,
- 12 slices of bacon
- 4 eggs,
- 2 cups of  $\frac{1}{2}$  &  $\frac{1}{2}$
- $\frac{3}{4}$  tsp. salt,
- $\frac{1}{8}$  tsp. black pepper
- 1- $\frac{1}{2}$  cups grated Swiss Cheese
- Pinch of nutmeg, sugar, cayenne
- 1 tsp dried minced onion

Rub butter on pie shell. Crumble cooked bacon over the bottom. Sprinkle w/cheese . Beat eggs,  $\frac{1}{2}$  &  $\frac{1}{2}$  milk & spices. Pour over cheese & bacon mixture. Bake @425 for 15" then reduce oven to 300 degrees for 40" or until knife comes out clean.

**Recipe****Sweet Potato Souffle**

3 cups mashed sweet potatoes (*I use 18 patties*)  
 ½ cup of milk,  
 2 eggs,  
 1 Tsp. vanilla,  
 1 cup sugar,  
 1 cup brown sugar  
 1/3 stick melted margarine,  
 ½ tsp. salt.

Mix all the above together. Put in 8 x 9 pan or casserole dish

**Topping**

1/3 stick of melted margarine  
 1/3 plain flour  
 1 cup brown sugar  
 ½ cup chopped nuts

Mix/ spread on top of Souffle. Bake @ 350 degrees for 30".
