The Architectural Committee would like to thank the property owners who made improvements to their property in 2013, and obtained the proper Paradise Valley permit before the improvements started.

If you are planning on improvements to your property, it would be advisable to check with the White County Building Inspector's office for guidance.

Most construction improvements (other than general maintenance) may require a County permit. Please keep in mind that a Paradise Valley permit may be required even though a County permit isn't required.

We only had a few leaks during the winter but thanks to JERRY COLEMAN, BOBBY PRIVETTE, VINNIE VESCUSO AND CLYDE CAMP, they were located early enough that no major damage occurred.

Just a reminder, PLEASE DO NOT put face or body wipes and feminine products in the toilet and also DO NOT pour grease down the sink or toilet.

Some have complained of a rotten egg odor in the water. This is most likely caused by your hot water heater. If you have an odor, drain your hot water heater tank and that should take care of the odor.

Remember, if you leave your lot for 24 hours or more; turn off the water at the main valve.

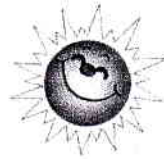


FROM THE ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE:

HONEY BUN CAKE (Submitted by June Brangham)

- 1 Box Yellow Cake Mix
- 1 Cup Sour Cream
- $\frac{3}{4}$ Cup Oil
- $\frac{1}{2}$ Cup Sugar
- 4 Eggs

Mix cake mix, sugar, oil & sour cream together. Add eggs one at a time and mix well. Mix 1 cup brown sugar, 2 teaspoons cinnamon and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup chopped pecans together well and set aside. Pour $\frac{1}{2}$ of the batter into well-greased 9 X 13 baking dish. Sprinkle $\frac{1}{2}$ of the brown sugar mixture over batter. Pour remaining batter on and top with remaining brown sugar mixture. Bake @ 325 degrees for 50-60 minutes.

GLAZE:

Mix 1 cup confectioner's sugar, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ table spoons milk and 1 teaspoon vanilla or almond flavoring together well. Drizzle over warm cake. Let cool before serving.



FRUIT SALAD

- 1 Can (29 oz.) sliced peaches, undrained
- 1 Can (20 oz) pineapple chunks, undrained
- 1 Small package Vanilla Instant Pudding Mix
- 1 Lb. strawberries, quartered
- 1 Banana, sliced
- $\frac{1}{2}$ Pint blueberries
- 1 bunch red grapes

In large bowl combine, undrained peaches and pineapple. Add dry pudding mix and Mix until pudding is dissolved. Stir in strawberries, banana, blueberries and grapes. Chill before serving.
NOTE: You may add 1 – 2 Tablespoons of sugar if desired.
