

Spicy Chicken Breast

Sprinkle 4 chicken breasts with Taco seasoning (a portion of the pkg. depending on your taste). Bake uncovered till the breasts are done. Pour on 1 can of Rotel (Mexican tomato sauce with lime juice) and top with cheddar cheese – bake again for about 20 minutes. Serve on top of rice.

Grape Salad

This salad was requested by several people who enjoyed it at a recent social function in our park.

4 c. red seedless grapes
4 c. green seedless grapes
8 oz. sour cream (light)
8 oz. cream cheese (1/3 less fat)
¾ c. white sugar
1 tsp. vanilla
1 c. brown sugar
½ c. pecan pieces

Mix the sour cream, cream cheese, white sugar and vanilla. Combine this mixture with the grapes. Arrange in a 9x13 glass dish. Sprinkle the brown sugar and pecans on top. Refrigerate over night.
